



End of year expectations for Year 2 Reading

By the end of year 2 children at Moreland are expected to:

Choose to read for pleasure and explain my choices.

Use phonics to read fluently.

Read words with two or more syllables using my phonics.

Read an increasing number of words on sight.

Sound out unfamiliar words accurately.

Re-read books to build up my fluency and confidence in word reading.

To discuss the sequence of events in books and how items of information are related.

Self-correct so that the text makes sense as it is being read.

Answer and ask questions using discussion.

Predict what might happen using what has been read so far.
