**By the end of year 6 children at Moreland are expected to:**

Choose to read for pleasure and explain my choices.

Apply knowledge of words I know to both to read aloud and to understand the meaning of new words.

Read books that are structured in different ways and read for a range of purposes.

Identify and discuss themes and conventions in and across a wide range of writing.

Make comparisons within and across books.

Ask questions to improve understanding of a text

Discuss and evaluate how authors use language, including figurative language, considering the impact on the reader.

Explain and discuss understanding of reading, including through formal presentations and debates, while maintaining a focus on the topic and using notes where necessary.

Provide reasoned justifications for my views.
